The former head of a multi-million-dollar Fyshwick security business faces a lengthy jail term after pleading guilty to drug trafficking and firearm offences.

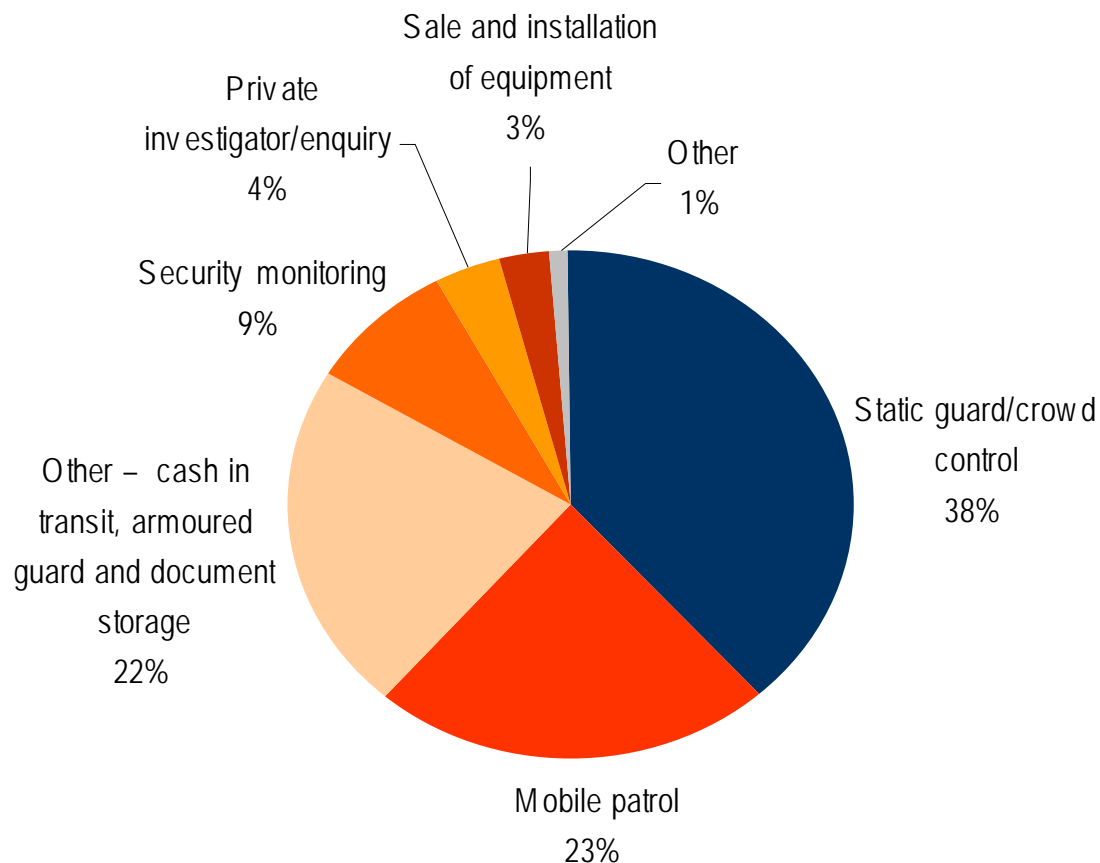
The ACT Magistrates Court heard yesterday that Michael Ian Law-

exceeded the jurisdiction of the Magistrates Court.

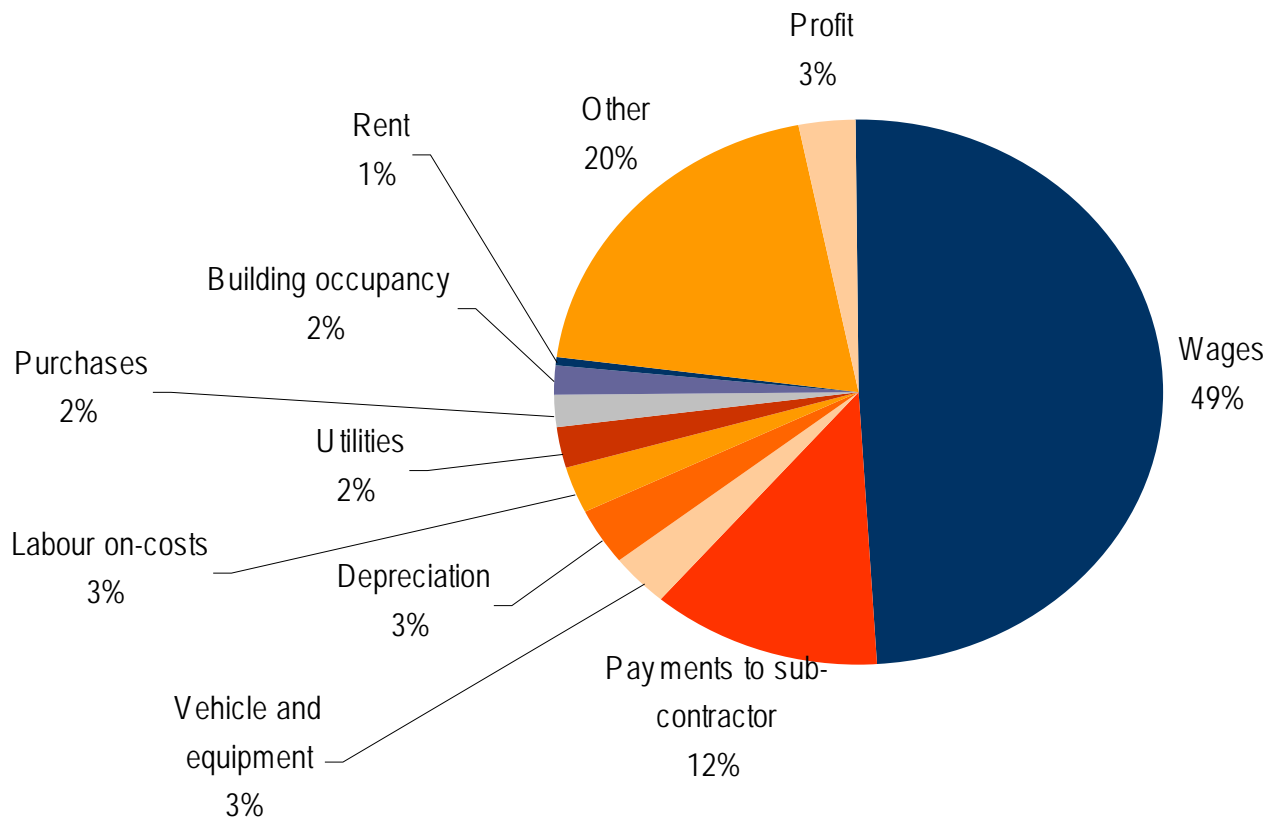
The Magistrates Court has a sentencing ceiling of two years' jail for any one charge.

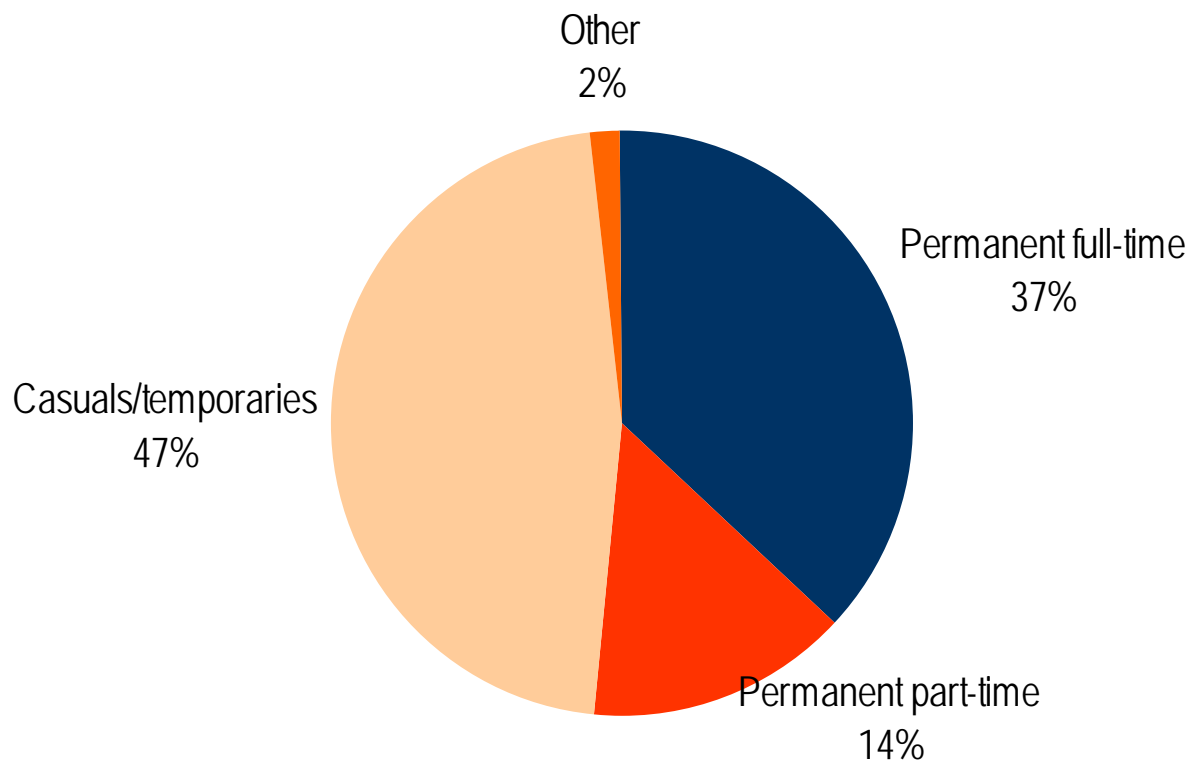
